SPARKLING WINES

CHAMPAGNE WHITE

Forget Brimont Brut Bottle £45.00 Glass £9.50

A classically structured, pure, biscuity blend of 40% Pinot Noir, 40% Pinot Meunier and 20% Chardonnay. The style here is all about drinkability and freshness with textbook crisp berry, brioche and citrus notes, and an exceptionally well balanced acidity.

Deutz Brut Classic £65.00

A delicious aperitif from Deutz, its Brut Classic Champagne showcases a blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay grapes. It's aged for at least three years before bottling, both full-bodied and crisp, with notes of fresh orchard fruit.

Veuve Clicquot £65.00

The Pinot Noir predominance provides the structure that is so typically Veuve Clicquot, while Chardonnay adds the elegance and finesse essential in a perfectly balanced wine, and a touch of Meunier rounds out the blend. The long aging in Crayères gives silkiness to the Champagne.

CHAMPAGNE ROSE

Forget Brimont Rose £45.00

Pouring a deep blush / salmon hue, this gentle rosé carries cherry, strawberry leather, wild raspberry, across a finely creamy palate, to a quieter spiced finish. Delicate.

Deutz Brut Rose £65.00

Ripe red berry and warm strawberry flavours on the palate with a lingering, gentle mousse and a toast and nutty finish. So easy to enjoy and very moreish.

PROSECCO

Prosecco Superior Valdobbiadene, D.O.C.G. Bottle £31.00 Glass £6.50

The wine exhibits fruity notes of golden apple and tropical fruits. Enjoy as an aperitif with appetizers and light fish dishes. This exceptional prosecco is the perfect complement to soft cheeses and desserts, like fruit tarts..



RED WINES

FRANCE

South

Pinot Noir Le Fou £29.00

Warm, rich nose with aromas of black cherry compote. The palate is nicely balanced with an exciting, savoury streak provided by ripe, tasty tannins

Beaujolais

Fleurie Domaine de Gry-Sablon

This wine is full of expressive Gamay characteristics with elegant violet, iris and red fruit aromas and a palate bursting with velvety tannins. A feminine wine with a long finish

Bordeaux

Chateau Parenchere £31.50

Merlot and Caberner Sauvignon. Very fleshy, with a very deeply coloured robe. Good balance between fruit and tannin, it displays distinct red fruit aromas with a long, sustained finish.

Chateau La Roque St.Emilion Grand Cru £77.00

Earthy and truffly complexity with mellow spice, profoundly deep flavours and a turbo-thrust of flavour that seems to pulse and boost even after you've sipped it. Sweetly savoury, enticing and fab.

Burgundy

Savigny-Les-Beaune Jean-Jaques Girard £75.00

Girard makes his wines in a supple style which makes them perfect for current drinking. Bags of red cherry fruit with a gentle finish of fine tannins.

Gevrey-Chambertin Pierre Bouree Fills £92.50

Really intense classic black cherry fruit with a firm robust finish. The masculine style of pinot noir which is drinking now but which will hold.

Rhone

Cotes du Rhone Domaine Lafond £32.00

Made from organically grown grapes this is supple with ripe spicy fruit. A friendly style of Cotes du Rhone which is drinking very well now.

Chateauneuf-du-Pape Andre Mathieu £83.00

Ruby-red colour with aromas of small red berries and spices. This is an elegant wine whose tannins integrate well with its rounded flavours.

PORTUGAL

Casa Ferreirinha, Douro £38.00

It has good volume, well integrated acidity, velvety tannins with notes of red fruits, and a delicate minerality. Its finish is elegant and persistent.

Murcas Assobio, Esporao £36.00

From the Douro Valley, it is made with the traditional port varieties of touriga nacional, touriga franca, and tinta roriz and displays vibrant red fruits. The perfect red with grilled meats or meaty pasta dishes and great value.

Azamor, Alentejo £42.00

Beautifully aromatic with a lush, deep red fruit perfume. On the palate, is well rounded with lots of delicious soft fruit flavours. The finish is long, with ripe tannins.

Esporao Reserva, Alentejo £49.50

Spicy red berry fruits with subtle oak complexity. Full bodied, textured palate, well structured tannins. Solid and dense with great potential for bottle maturation.

AUSTRALIA

Dandelion Lionheart, Shiraz, Barossa £39.50

Spicy pepper and hints of bramble and dark chocolate. Mouth-filling sweet blackberries, raspberries and plums cover the palate with lashings of sweet spice.

ITALY

Salice Salentino, Giardinelli £32.00

The palate has a touch of spice to balance the black fruit and ripe tannins. A wonderful balance of sweet ripeness and bitterness, typical of Negro Amaro, held together by fresh acidity.

Valpolicella Ripasso, Villa Borghetti £45.00

The Venetian wine made from dried grapes. This gives the wine greater depth and richness but it still retains Valpolicella's inherent which makes it ideal for cutting through richly sauced dishes.

Chianti Reserva, La Scoperta Uggiano £38.00

Vibrant black fruit aromas with a touch of spice. On the palate layers of ripe plum, blackcurrant and juicy black cherry balance spicy, developed flavours.

Barolo, Alasia £62.00

Floral aromas with richness and structure. Dark plum, leather and delicate violet aromas, plus notes of woodsmoke and brown. A full, firm and ripe red with rich, powerful flavours.

Amarone Villa Borghetti Pasqua £78.00

A vigorous, full-bodied deep ruby red wine. Clean and vibrant fragrances of currants, blackberries and sweet almonds on the nose, with notes of vanilla.

NEW ZEALAND

Sileni, Pinot Noir Hawkes Bay £40.00

It's fresh and bright with a fine almond skin appeal. The wine remains fresh throughout with a lovely defining acidity which makes this a great food match by the glass.

Roaring Meg, Pinot Noir Central Otago £58.00

It exhibits a lovely mix of red and black berry fruits with further complexity gained from oak spice. The wine has a sweet berry palate.

ARGENTINA

Altos, Mendoza Malbec £42.00

Notes of red fruits, cherries and freshly picked plums. This wine is all about freshness - the palate is supple and juicy, with soft but structured tannins and a pleasant finish.

Colome, Malbec £63.00

Aromas of black and red fruits including blackberries, blackcurrants, raspberries and cherries, with touches of violet floral notes and hints of spices and minerals. Fresh and fruity on the palate.

SOUTH AFRICA

Bon Courage Estate Pepper Tree Shiraz £30.00

Full-bodied wine suggests ripe fruit reminiscent of spicy plums and ripe berry fruit. Pepper and vanilla flavours.

Le Riche Richesse, Cabernet/Merlot £41.50

Mouth-filling flavours of red berries, plums and smoky hints balanced with a fine, soft tannic structure and rounded finish. A finely structured and harmonious blend.

SPAIN

Rioja Crianza, Vina Marro £38.00

The wine has expensive mature fruit on the nose with mineral notes and spice. On the palate it has ripe, mature tannins that make for a smooth but lengthy finish

Rioja Reserva Especial Izadi £51.00

Fresh and fragrant nose, boasting aromas of redcurrant, cherry and plum with notes of tobacco, toasted oak and spices. The palate is pure and rich with long, fruit-forward finish.

Rioja Grand Reserva Especial Urbina £80.00

A glorious harmony of rich oak and dark red fruits such as dates, prunes and sweet raisins. A brilliantly smooth texture with well balanced tannins and excellent acidity, leading to a creamy and very long lasting finish.

WHITE WINES

FRANCE

Burgundy

Macon Lugny Eugene Blanc £38.50

The fruity and floral aromas make it a rich and full wine, slightly spicy on the finish. You can enjoy it as an aperitif or to accompany poultry, fish or goat cheese.

Petit Chablis Domaine Garnier £47.00

Exotic blend of citrus and hawthorn on the nose. The attack is soft leading to minerality and fullness, flavour of yellow fruit.

Chablis Domain Garnier £54.00

Mainly calcareous and mineral touches typical of the Kimmeridgian soil rich in clay, limestone and fossil remains.

Puligny-Montrachet Jean Pascal £90.00

Loads of sparky energy and density on the palate. Tight structure, persistent with a long mineral finish. Floral and ripe with a slight hint of nuttiness.

Loire

Muscadet Serve et Maine Peninsula Gadais £33.00

Ample, fresh, complex, floral, with notes of stony mineral, and a fresh long finish.

Sancerre Christian Salmon £54.00

The nose is intense, with good balance between freshness, fruit, vivacity and finesse that complement its minerality. Notes of citrus fruit and lime on the palate with a touch of mint.

Pouilly Fume Chateau de Tracy £63.00

Subtle and aromatic with lovely concentration. Medium to full-bodied on the palate with ripe white fruits and a tangy acidity.

ITALY

Verdicchio Coste de Molino £31.50

Fresh intense aromas of grapefruit and lime, as well as honeyed stone fruit. The palate is fresh and fruity; very approachable, with apple, pear and ripe stone fruit.

La Segreta Bianco Planeta £38.00

The fresh bouquet reveals to the nose a lively aroma of refreshing citrus fruits, ripe peaches and papaya - perfectly accompanied by floral notes of chamomile. On the palate, this Italian white wine convinces with a balanced body that harmonizes perfectly with the refined acidity structure.

Pinot Grigio Ponte Del Diavolo £36.50

Light, bright lemon in colour with a lively, freshly cut pear and baked bread character on the nose.

Soave Classico Superiore Otto Pra £42.00

A pale-yellow colour, its bouquet bursting with notes of flowers (hawthorn and jasmine) and yellow fresh fruits (drupe, peach and apricots). On the palate, the wine is medium bodied and flavoursome, full of fruit, with clear mineral notes.

Gavi di Gavi, Lugarara £51.00

The wine's aromas of white fruit, stone fruit and lime zest are immediately beguiling and followed by a subtle yet persistent bouquet of green apples. The palate is well balanced with a fresh acidity and good structure. Pleasant almond notes linger on the finish.

NEW ZEALAND

Pinot Gris, Sileni, Hawkes Bay £34.00

Ripe, juicy stone fruit, pear and citrus flavours, with a little spice and beautifully balanced acidity.

Riversdale, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough £35.00

Light and fresh with classic green, grass and citrus aromas and flavours. On the palate there is asparagus, gooseberry and zesty acidity which makes this wine a great match with oysters, chicken with tarragon and roasted vegetables with wild rice.

PORTUGAL

Muralhas De Moncao, Vinho Verde £32.00

Filled with fresh aromas of peach and apricot, its flavor persists in the mouth with the smoothness and freshness that only a historic Vinho Verde can offer.

Casa Ferreirinha Planalto, Douro £36.00

A fresh, dry Portuguese white from high-altitude vineyards which bring freshness to the resulting wine. Lower yields in 2020 have brought a little more weight and depth to the wine, nicely balanced by the refreshing acidity.

Esporao Reserva, Esporao £42.00

Smooth, unctuous and rich, this is a gorgeous wine that offers ripe peach and pineapple fruits to go with the fine acidity and hint of spice.

SPAIN

Verdejo Diez Siglos Rueda £30.00

Intense aromas of stone fruit, tangerine oil and citrus. A rounded and complex palate, with peach and apricot fruit and notes of grass and fennel. Textural, though bright and pure with a long finish.

Albarino Abadia de San Campio £48.00

The wine shows elegant notes of fresh citrus and tropical fruits coming along with peachy aromas. The mouth is round with a refreshing acidity that makes it perfect to go with seafood!

SOUTH AFRICA

Kleindal Sauvignon Blanc £30.00

Full Bodied with powerful varietal flavors of bell pepper, green apple and freshly cut grass.

Circumstance, Chenin Blanc, Stellenbosch £37.00

The nose is enormously redolent of Manuka honey and yellow pollen. The palate is soft and creamy with citrus and a wonderful textural minerality, waxy lanolin notes and honey. Lovely palate weight and Vouvray-like body supports further complexity and decadence.

Jordan, Chardonnay Unoaked, Stellenbosch £39.00

A totally unique unoaked offering that is defined partly by extended lees contact that develops mouthfeel and nuance in the wine. Aromas of freshly grated lemon zest and citrus orchard that finishes with flavours of apricot puree and lime sorbet.

ROSE WINES

Malbek Malbec Rose, France £28.00

Pretty, pink and medium bodied. A balance of delicate aromas, juicy raspberry and succulent strawberry flavours.

Sossego, Alentejano Rose, Portugal 2020 £33.00

Pink-cherry color, intense cherry aroma and red berries. In the mouth it appears, fresh, balanced. Long finish.

M11 Minutes, Veneto, Pasqua, Italy £36.00

The Corvina varietal, which dominates in terms of percentage, was chosen for the floral aromas as well as the significant acidity it gives to the wine. Trebbiano brings elegance and a long finish; Syrah gives fine fruit and spice notes to the glass and finally, Carmenere creates structure, ensuring stability over time.

Provence Rose, Chateau L'Aumerade, France £45.00

Lovely pale pink in colour. The fresh nose is composed of citrus aromas such as orange and grapefruit complemented by a full, spicy and fleshy palate with refreshing acidity.
